



Complaints Handling Procedures for Auctions

In the event that you have reason to submit a formal complaint in respect of our Auctions Services please note the below procedure is in place to ensure we handle your complaint efficiently and professionally.

- 1) Please submit your complaint in writing, by post to:

Please head your letter "Formal Complaint".

- 2) We will acknowledge receipt of your complaint in writing within three working days.
- 3) Mr Simon Caplin simonc@psandb.co.uk, Head of Auctions, will review your complaint and you will receive a formal response within 15 days.
- 4) If you remain dissatisfied with our response you may submit your reasons in writing, by post please, with the letter headed "Formal Complaint" and addressed to Mr Peter Hewett, CEO, peter@bluebombini.com, who will respond with a final decision within 15 days from the referral date. Your letter should be supported by a copy of all preceding complaint correspondence.
- 5) If you remain dissatisfied with our final decision we will advise you of your right to refer your complaint to The Property Ombudsman: Property who will independently review the complaint in accordance with their procedures. Their details are as follows:
